# ICE CREAM PINATA

### YOU WILL NEED:

2 large pieces of card  
Tissue Paper  
String  
Sweets / Toys

Scissors  
Pen / Pencil  
Tape  
Modelling Clay

1. Draw an ice cream shape on a large piece of card and cut it out. Use this cut out as a template and draw around it to make a second.

2. Tape strips of card - roughly 10cm in width, along one of the edges of the ice cream to make it 3D. I curved the card as it made it a bit easier to shape.

3. Turn the ice cream on one end. Place a ball of modelling clay under the card and push a sharp pencil through it. Pull a piece of string through the hole and tie a large knot.

4. Tape the second ice cream shape on top. I left a flap on the chocolate stick so that I could put in my sweets and treats in later.

5. Fold up the strips of tissue paper. I used yellow for the cone which I cut into a curve, white for the ice cream, which I cut slits into and red for some strawberry sauce, which I cut into a wavy line. When you open these up you should see a repeat pattern.

6. Once you've cut all your shapes, use a glue stick to attach the strips to your pinata. I also scrunched up some brown tissue paper to give a chocolate effect on the chocolate stick.

7. Finally fill your pinata with goodies and find something to hit it with.
