FACT SHEET



BALLOON CELL PICTURE

YOU WILL NEED:

Cardboard
Ruler
Pen
Scissors
Cling Film

Glue
Paint
Paint Brush
Digital Camera



1. Take two rectangular pieces of thick cardboard and a ruler. Use the width of the ruler to draw a frame around the edge of the card, you'll need to do this twice.



2. Cut out the centre of the pieces of card so you are left with two frames. You can do this by putting modelling clay under the card and pushing a pencil through to make a hole, or ask an adult.



3. Use a glue stick to spread glue around the edge of the frames. Stretch a sheet of cling film across the middle, making it nice and taut. Stick the other frame over the top so the cling film is sandwiched in the middle.



4. Draw a picture on to the cling film with a permanent marker pen. It is a good idea to draw your picture on a piece of paper first, put it under the cling film, and trace over the top. Draw each picture differently to add some movement, you can then use these to make an animation.

5. Colour the picture with permanent marker or acrylic paint.

6. Make a cardboard box frame to hold all of your pictures. You can also make a foreground and background for this.

7. Once your pictures are complete you can turn them into an animation by using an animation app.
