WHAT WILL WE COLLECT AND HOW WILL WE USE IT?

The BBC will collect and process the personal information that you have provided to us about yourself and your child by submitting your application including your child's name, age, date of birth, address and a contact telephone number. We will request additional information from you if your application is shortlisted. **///** The BBC is the "data controller" of this information. This means that the BBC decides what your personal data is used for, and the ways in which it is processed for the purposes of the competition. Where not overridden by your interests, the BBC processes your personal information for this purpose on the basis of the BBC's legitimate interests in administering competitions in a fair and proper manner.

RETAINING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

The BBC will retain your personal information until December 18th 2020. If you are successful with your application, we will retain your personal information for two years.

SHARING YOUR INFORMATION

If you are successful, your child's first name will be disclosed to the public. Due to the nature of the competition, if your application is shortlisted, we will request additional information from you.
