
Make an Origami Bunny





You will need


- 1 x piece of paper


Instructions

Step 1



To make your bunny you will need a square piece of paper, if you only have A4 you can easily turn this into a square.

Step 2




Do this by taking one corner and pulling it to the other side until it meets. You will then be left with a rectangle at the bottom, cut this off.


Step 3



You will now be left with a triangle like this.



Then fold in half again to make Open up your triangle so it an even smaller triangle.



looks like this with a crease line down the middle.




Take the bottom of the triangle and fold it over a couple of centimetres so it looks like this (a bit like a boat!).



Take the tip and fold it downwards a couple of centimetres so the point lines up with the centre crease.



Take one of the bottom corners and pull it towards the top and line it up with the middle crease so it looks like this.



Then do the same to the other side.



Then grab the bottom point and fold it upwards a couple of centimetres, this will enable your bunny to stand up.



Turn your bunny over and it should look a little like this.



Now you can decorate your bunny how you like. We have added a nose with cotton wool and some whiskers with pipe cleaners and topped it off with some googly eyes! Happy Easter!
