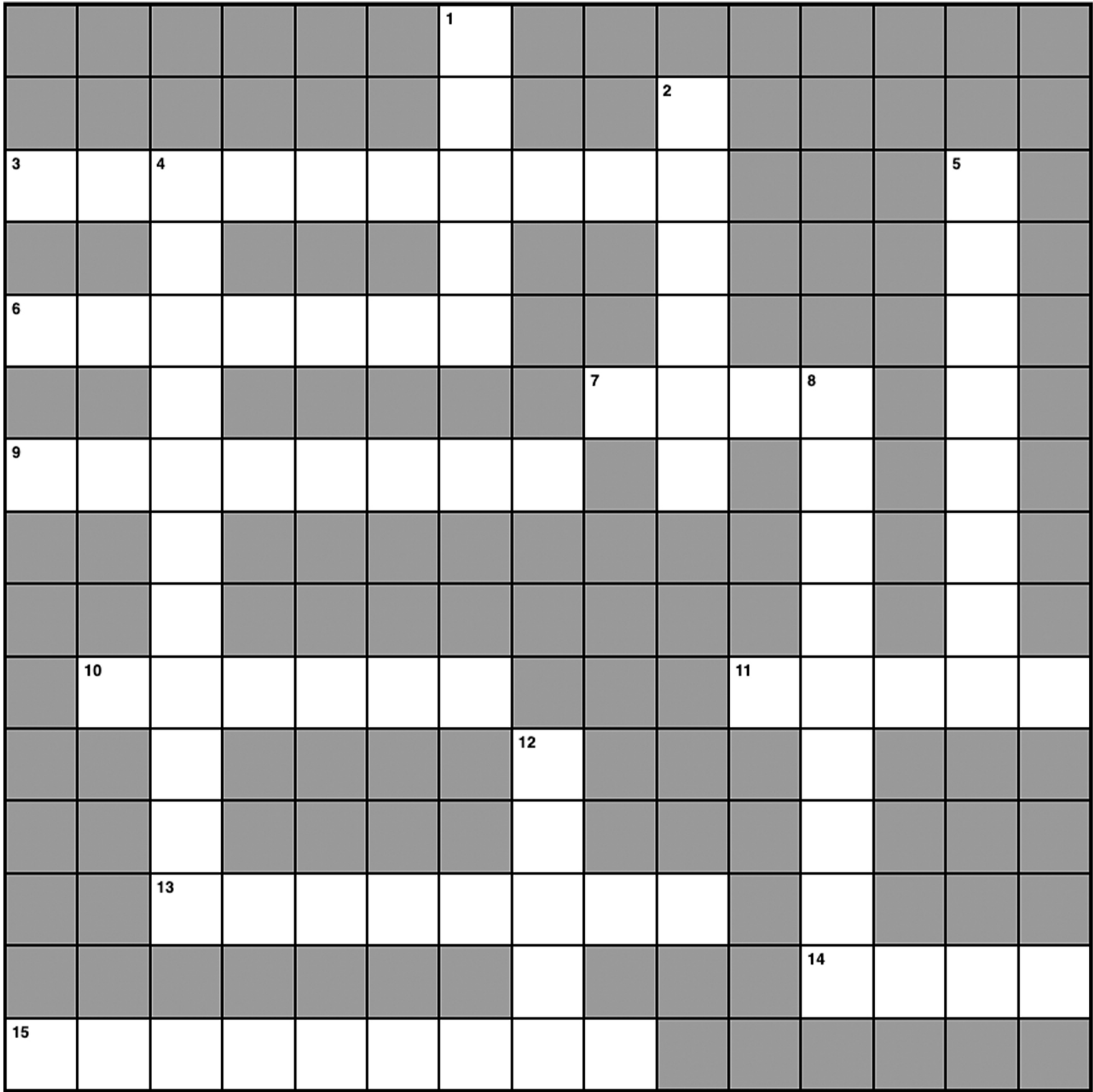




How closely were you watching the latest series of Horrible Histories? From Terrible Tudors to The Roaring 20s, this lot had it all.
