MAKE A FRIEND



YOUR OWN WALKING LEAF:

Use some glue to stick your leaf below so that it matches up with the legs.

STICK YOUR LEAF HERE!



Then take a marker or texta and draw a smile and an eye on your leaf! Or you could also glue a button or googly eye on the leaf if you have one.

MAKE A YOUR OWN MOBLIE



DECORATE YOUR TENT:

Make a mobile using found things like sticks, leaves, shells and feathers.



- Find a thick stick to be the base of your hanger.
- Next, take each one of your found items and tie a string around it, and then to the stick. Repeat this for each of your items, using different length of string each time.
- Then tie one piece of long string to either end of the stick to make a handle.
- Finally, find a place on your tent to hang your new nature mobile!

WHAT CAN YOU SEE AROUND YOU:

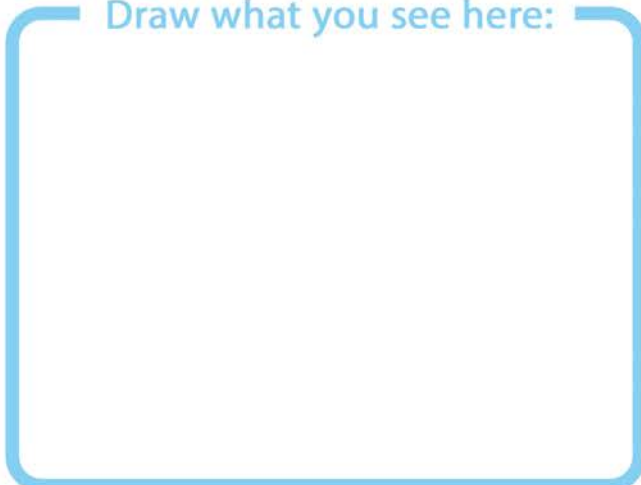
- Draw what you see outside your tent.

How many of these can you find?
(Tick them off as you go.)

- A leaf bigger than your hand

- A rock that looks like a face (or you can always draw one on with a texta!) 
- A piece of rubbish – pick it up and put it in the bin!
- Something spikey (a pine cone, or seed.)
