



Hey Duggee Enid Halloween Costume Crochet Pattern *by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)*

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook ● Scissors
 - Darning needle
 - Black Felt

Yarn:

Any DK Cotton in

- ● A - Orange (Pumpkin main) 10g
- ● B - Green (Pumpkin leaves) - 2g
- ● C - Black (Face detail) - A long strand

Terminology (UK Terms):

- ● slst: slip stitch
- ● ch: chain
- ● dc: double crochet
- ● MR: Magic ring
- ● inc: increase
- ● dec: decrease



****Before you start, if you have made Enid before, you will need to take her head off to put the Pumpkin costume on. And if you are in the process of making Enid, make sure to leave sewing the head on until you get to the pumpkin****

Pumpkin

In yarn A:

1. ch 20, connect to the first stitch on the chain to make a loop, dc 19 (20) 2. (dc 4, inc) x4 (24)
 3. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)
 4. (dc 4, inc) x6 (36)
 5. (dc 5, inc) x6 (42)
 - 6-8. dc around (42)
 9. (dc 2, dec) x10, dc 2 (32)
 10. (dc 4, dec) x5, dc 2 (27)
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Pumpkin Trim

In yarn B:

1. ch 20, dc in 2nd chain from the hook and dc 19 (20)
2. Slst, (ch3, slst in next st) x19. **See fig.1 & 2**
 - Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
 - Sew onto the rim of the top of the pumpkin. **See fig.3**
 - Sew Enid's body back onto her head.

Pumpkin Face:

- • Cut out two triangles from black felt (bottom edge about 1cm)
- • Sew or glue them on the front of the pumpkin outfit with the bottom edge in line with R6.

See fig. 4

- • With a long strand of black yarn, sew a zig-zag mouth one row below the eyes.

See fig. 5

Hat

In yarn **A**:

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc into each st around (12)

• Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing. **Hat Leaves**

In Yarn **B**, make 2:

1. Ch 4 and fasten off
 - • Fold in half and sew to the top of the hat in the middle. **See fig. 6**
 - • Sew the hat on Enid's head in front of her ears. **See fig. 7**

And you're finished!

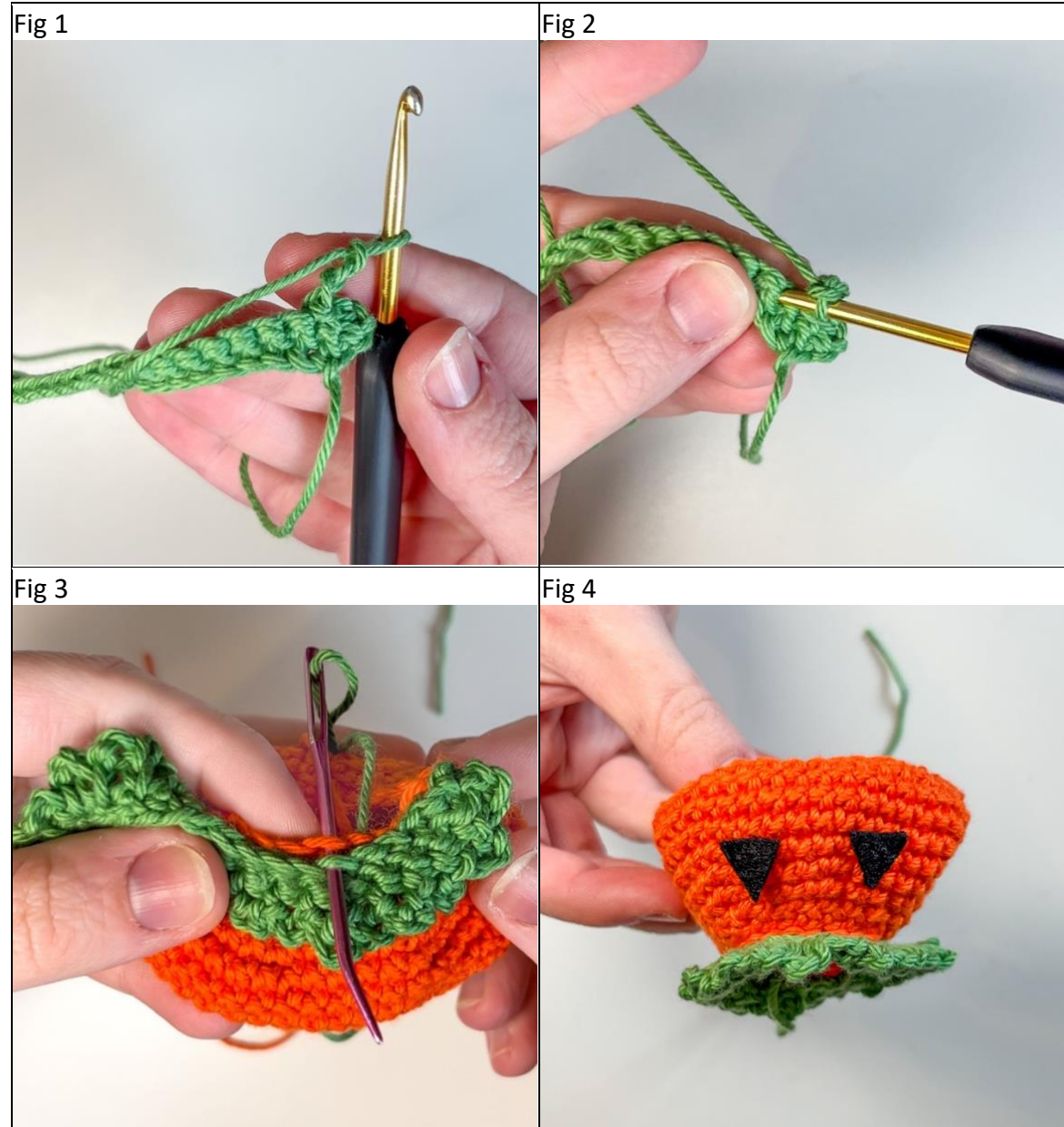
