



MEASUREMENTS & SIZES 28cm

KNIT KIT

Yarn: King Cole Pricewise DK, shades (A) 055 Gold, (B) 201 Cloud, (C) 128 Fondant, (D) 038 Acid, (E) 048 Black, one 100g ball of each (other yarn brands in similar colours are available)

Needles: 3.5mm Safety toy stuffing Safety toy eyes: blue, 17mm

Felt: pink, soft pink, white, navy blue, sky blue, orange, bright yellow-green, yellow-green

Stitch holder Glue

TENSION SQUARE

24 sts x 32 rows

Tapestry needle

- 10cm x 10cm
- Stocking stitch
- 3.5mm needles

ABBREVIATIONS

beg - beginning

k - knit

kfb - knit into the front and back of next stitch

k2tog - knit two stitches together

mm - millimeters

p - purl

rem - remain(ing)

RS - right side

st(s) - stitch(es)

st st - stocking stitch

WS - wrong side



KNIT THIS FAVOURITE MOON AND ME CHARACTER, DESIGNED BY SACHIYO ISHII

Start knitting here

LEFT LEG

Using 3.5mm needles and yarn C, cast on 18 sts

 \square Rows 1-2: beg with a k (RS) row, work in st st

Row 3: k2tog, k to last two sts, k2tog. 16 sts

 \square Rows 4-23: beg with a p row, work in st st Cut yarn, leaving sts on a holder

RIGHT LEG

☐ Work as for Left leg but do not cut yarn

BODY

Row 24: p16 sts of Right leg, p16 from holder. 32 sts

 \square Row 25: k14, (k2tog) twice, k to end. 30 sts

Row 26: p to end

Cut yarn C, change to yarn B \square Rows 27-42: beg with a k

As Pepi Nana is likely to be given to very young children, choose safety toy stuffing which is certified to be fire safe and free from toxins and harmful substances. Make sure you clip in the safety toy eyes really securely and oversew your seams to withstand playtime. Use a strong glue to attach the stars securely - you can also reinforce the attachment with a few small stitches.

HEAD

Using 3.5mm needles and yarn A, cast on 12 sts

 \square Row 1 (WS): p to end

 \square Row 2: (k1, kfb) three times,

(kfb, k1) three times. 18 sts ☐ Row 3 and every WS row:

p to end

Row 4: (k2, kfb) three times, (kfb, k2) three times.

24 sts

Row 6: (k3, kfb) three times, (kfb, k3) three times. 30 sts

Row 8: (k4, kfb) three times, (kfb, k4) three times.

36 sts

Row 10: (k5, kfb) three times, (kfb, k5) three times.

42 sts Row 12: (k6, kfb) three times, (kfb, k6 three times.

48 sts Row 14: (k7, kfb) three times, (kfb, k7) three times.

54 sts Row 16: (k8, kfb) three

times, (kfb, k8) three times. 60 sts

 \square Rows 17-27: cont in st st Row 28: (k8, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k8) three times. 54 sts

☐ Rows 29-31: cont in st st ☐ Row 32: (k7, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k7) three times. 48 sts

Row 34: (k6, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k6) three times. 42 sts

□ Row 36: (k5, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k5) three times. 36 sts

Row 38: (k4, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k4) three times. 30 sts

Row 40: (k3, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k3) three times. 24 sts

 □ Row 42: (k2, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k2) three times. 18 sts

Row 44: (k1, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k1) three times. 12 sts

Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

NOSE

Using 3.5mm needles and yarn A, cast on eight sts Cut yarn leaving a tail, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

SHORTS LEFT LEG

Using 3.5mm needles and yarn D, cast on 22 sts Rows 1-7: beg with a k (RS) row, work in st st Cut yarn, leaving sts on a holder

SHORTS RIGHT LEG

☐ Work as for Left leg, but do not cut yarn

SHORTS

twice. 40 sts

Row 8: p22 sts of Right leg, p22 from holder. 44 sts □ Row 9: (k2tog, k18, k2tog)

 \square Row 10: p to end

 \square Row 11: (k8, k2tog) to end. 36 sts

Row 12: p to end

 \square Row 13: (k7, k2tog) to end. 32 sts

Rows 14-15: cont in st st

☐ Cast off

SHOES

(make two) Using 3.5mm needles and yarn E, cast on 12 sts \square Row 1 (WS): p to end

 □ Row 2: (kfb) to end. 24 sts □ Rows 3-4: beg with a p row, work in st st □ Row 5 (edge): k to end □ Rows 6-10: beg with a k row, work in st st □ Row 11: p8, (p2tog) four times, p8. 20 sts Change to yarn C □ Row 12: k to end □ Row 13: p7, (p2tog) three times, p7. 17 sts □ Rows 14-15: beg with a k row, work in st st □ Cast off
SHIRT Using 3.5mm needles and yarn B, cast on 44 sts ☐ Rows 1-8: beg with a k (RS) row, work in st st ☐ Row 9: (k9, k2tog) to end. 40 sts ☐ Rows 10-14: cont in st st ☐ Row 15: (k8, k2tog) to end. 36 sts ☐ Rows 16-20: cont in st st ☐ Row 21: (k4, k2tog) to end. 30 sts ☐ Rows 22-24: cont in st st ☐ Row 25: (k3, k2tog) to end. 24 sts ☐ Rows 26-27: beg with a p row, work in st st ☐ Cast off
SHIRT SLEEVES (make two) Using 3.5mm needles and yarn B, cast on 18 sts Rows 1-17: beg with a p (WS) row, work in st st Cast off POCKET Using 3.5mm needles and yarn B, cast on nine sts Rows 1-8: beg with a k (RS) row, work in st st Cast off
HANDS (make two) Using 3.5mm needles and yarn A, cast on 12 sts Rows 1-5: beg with a p (WS) row, work in st st Row 6: cast off six sts, k1, turn, leaving rem sts on LH needle

Cont on these two sts for first

 \square Beg with a p row, work four

Leave these these sts on RH

needle, kfb, turn. Two sts

rows in st st on these two

■ ** Return to Row 6 sts on LH

 \square Beg with a p row, work six

finger

needle

rows in st st


TO MAKE UP

Sew each leg seam to crotch. Sew body seam to neck, then stuff. Place Shorts on body and sew seam. Secure Shorts to body. Fold Shoe in half longways and sew sole and back seam. Stuff Shoe and sew to Leg. Place Shirt on body and sew back seam. Attach Pocket. Fold fingers lengthways and sew each side

seam. Close hand opening. Sew Sleeve seam, lightly stuff Sleeve then insert hand into Sleeve, securing hand at cuff. Stitch ends of Nose together to make a bobble. Sew Nose to face. Using Dark Brown DK, embroider eyebrows, eyelashes and mouth. Using yarn B, sew two lines over eyebrows. With yarn C, embroider dots on face as shown. For hair, wind yarn E around a 25cm piece of card 10-15 times. Slide off card, place across head and sew centre. Repeat to achieve desired volume. To finish, wind yarn around a 15cm piece of card 10-15 times to make smaller tassels. Sew to top of head. Cut loops and trim. Sew

Head to body. Cut out stars and glue or sew them to Shirt LK
