# Rocket Jet Pack





## You will need

- 2 large plastic bottles (remove tops)
- 2 disposable drinking cups
  - 1 piece of cardboard (the width of the two bottles when they are laid side by side)
- Red and orange crepe paper or streamers
- 2 long pieces of ribbon
- Sticky tape or glue
  - Scissors (grown-up use only)
- Tin foil or silver paint
  - Decorations e.g. paint, stickers, pens

### Introduction

Have fun zooming around with this cool rocket jet pack!

# Instructions



To make the jets, wrap each bottle in tin foil or cover them in paint.




Ask a grown-up to cut the bottom off each drinking cup, then cover the cups in tin foil or paint.



Cover your cardboard with tin foil or paint. When the paint has dried, lay your bottles side by side on top of your cardboard with the bottle necks pointing downwards. Stick them to the cardboard.



To create the straps, attach a piece of ribbon to the top and bottom corner of one edge of the cardboard. Repeat for the other edge. Make sure the straps are lose enough for little arms to poke through.



To make the flames, tear the crepe paper into long strips.



Using glue or tape, attach the strips to the inside rim of the cups.



Attach the flames to the jets by taping the bottom of each cup over the neck of each bottle.



Your rocket jet pack is complete!
