



BLUEY FESTIVE CRAFTS

CHRISTMAS WRAPPING PAPER

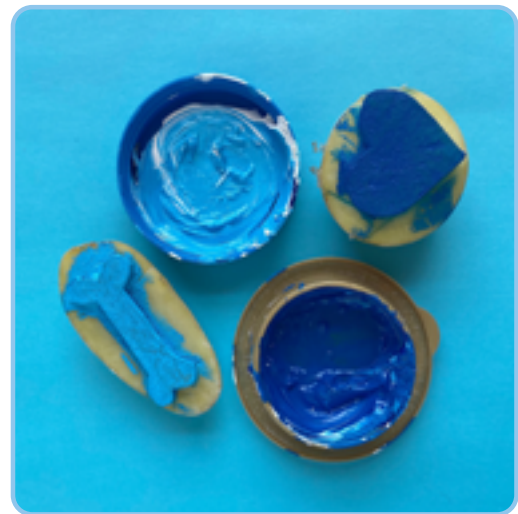


You will need:

- A potato
- Plain paper recycled newspapers
- Brown card
- Blue or beige ribbon
- Marker pen (sharpie)
- Brush
- Bluey paint (light and dark blue)
- Paper towel recycled newspapers
- Safe glue
- Scissors (grown-up use only)

Instructions:

1. Using a marker pen, draw a bone on the brown card to create your Christmas card.
2. Ask a grown up to help you cut out the shape.
3. Go on a treasure hunt to find a good sized potato.
4. Ask a grown-up to cut the potato in half, and dry both halves with paper towel.
5. Draw a heart shape on one slice, then a bone on the other with a sharpie pen.
6. Ask a grown-up to carve the shapes out using a knife to create your own stamps.
7. Prepare the paint and stamps.

8. Apply paint onto the stamps with a brush, testing and dabbing off the excess on a scrap of paper.

9. Stamp your design all over your wrapping paper and let dry. If you already have a specific box to wrap, you can precut the paper to fit that box.

10. Cut the paper to fit your present and wrap normally.

11. Finish it off by gluing the back of Christmas card from step 1 to your present and tie it with the ribbon.
